

WEST SUSSEX SCHOOLS & YOUTH SAILING ASSOCIATION DINGHY SENIOR INSTRUCTOR COURSE 2016

WHAT?

The Senior Instructor (SI) is an experienced instructor who has been assessed as competent to organise and manage courses within the RYA's Sailing Scheme. They are qualified to organise and control group sailing tuition and to supervise and assist instructors. SIs must be confident, competent managers, capable of organising groups of all ages and directing the work of their instructors. Because this course is run on coastal water, it will be a coastal award.

WHO?

Candidates must first be an RYA dinghy instructor and must fulfil the following criteria prior to the SI course:

- Minimum age 18;
- Two years intermittent or one year full time dinghy instructing experience since DI;
- RYA Safety Boat certificate from a coastal location;
- Valid first aid certificate;
- Signed recommendation from the Principal or an RYA training centre;
- RYA Safe & Fun safeguarding certificate.

During the course candidates will be asked to demonstrate that they have sailing ability to at least the standard of an RYA dinghy instructor.

WHEN?

A 4 day course split over 2 weekends: 13/14 and 20/21 February 2016

TRAINING

Courses are run on a regional basis with a minimum of six students. Courses are organised through the Regional Development Officer and staffed by two or more RYA Coach/Assessors, including Matthew Wright and Hermione Garner. The course will include:

- organizing and managing sessions afloat
- leading and participating in group discussions on sail training issues
